 - Participants will be assigned to 2 groups based on the work of each presenter (**30 minutes**). Based on their assigned presentation they will think through the following:

 5. What are some potential strategies for best practices when working with this population (in research/programming?)
 6. What are some potential strategies for promoting sustainable development outcomes when working with this population?
 7. What do you consider to be next steps for conducting work with this population and in this specific field (i.e., youth sport, entrepreneurship, and/or sustainable development).
 - Each group will designate a reporter that will briefly share the results of their discussion (**25 minutes**).
